came flying in to hear.

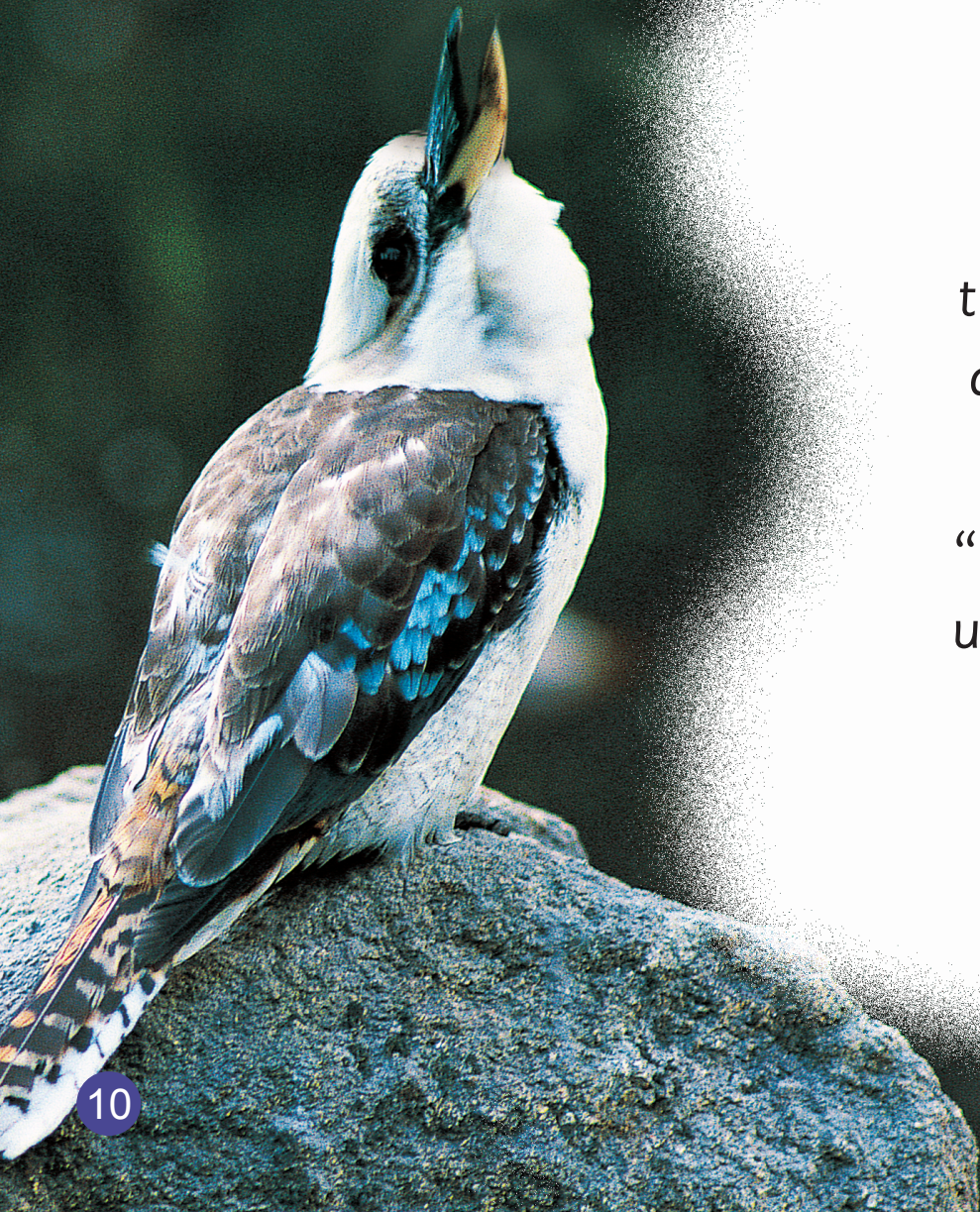




They listened excitedly as the little kookaburra told them what he had seen.
